


EDF - Display Screen Equipment

EDF - Stress Management and Awareness

EDF asked us to develop a course to increase awareness of stress and the role of EDF's Occupational Health Team in helping to manage stress. We designed a course using scenarios to bring the content to life, and ensure the learning has a very real and contextualised feel. Learners are introduced to a number of virtual work colleagues, each experiencing difficulties in their lives which are affecting their work. The learner has to decide if and when the Occupational Health Team needs to get involved. They then see the consequences of their decisions play out.









AstraZeneca - Fire Safety

We developed a course for AstraZeneca which introduces learners to the basics of fire safety. We used an immersive narrative to show a fire occurring on site. The learner is then taken back in time to discover why the fire started and how it could have been prevented.

AstraZeneca - Security, Health and the Environment

Kallidus developed a refresher course which was taken by all of AstraZeneca's auditors prior to conducting an audit. The e-learning was an integral part of a blended solution. We designed the course to simulate the complex audit process, allowing learners to practise real-world auditing skills in a virtual environment. The learners visit the site of Pharmacentrix after a process failure and have to conduct their own investigation into the matter. They use a virtual notepad to record their observations and actions which are used by their appraisers to evaluate and certify the learners as ready to audit.








BG Group
